

Level 4: Critical Infringement



Administration Handled

- Steps:
- 1) Immediately request to have student removed.
 - 2) Complete a referral and log in Powerschool

Strategies: - remain calm and reiterate classroom expectations and try to build relationship with the student so reintegration will be easier

Level 3: 3rd or 4th minor incident or Major Incident



Administration Handled

- Steps:
- 1) Address the behavior and the expected behavior.
 - 2) Request to have student sent to the office with referral so principal can address behavior appropriately.
 - 3) Log the referral in Powerschool

Strategies: - Remain calm and reiterate classroom expectations and try to build the relationship with the student so reintegration will be easier.

Level 2: 2nd/3rd Minor Incident



Teacher Handled Referral

- Steps:
- 1) Teacher addresses behavior using classroom management strategies and established tier 2 intervention.
 - 2) Document the incident using the referral form and enter it into Powerschool and contact parent about the incident.

Strategies: - Take a break in class- loss of privilege- Mediation with student leading to reflection and apology so student can reintegrate with healing.

Level 1: Minor Incident



Teacher Handled- Teacher Documented

- Steps:
- 1) Address the behavior by using classroom management strategies and established tier 1 and 2 interventions.
 - 2) Document incident if appropriate and make appropriate contact with parents if necessary.

Strategies: -Clear expectations -Create a classroom culture of reteaching and modeling - Ensure healing has happened before reintegration
