## 2.0 Admin Updates

- **2.1** Dave Martin shared that the first graduation class at PCA will be May 22, 2025 at Pueblo Community College in the Fortino ballroom. Enrollment is working on backfilling kindergarten and 6th grade network wide. Professional development is currently being developed for pre-k. PSAS will partner with local headstarts and daycares to develop relationships. Mr. Martin formally introduced Elgin Fitzgerald as the new ESS director. Fire alarm updates will happen this summer at all campuses. PSAS charter is up for renewal this year. Mr. Martin has compiled a team that will begin work this month. The audit has begun and Theresa Shoda will share updates as it progresses. State testing has finished and went smoothly.
- **2.2** Rosann Walker shared the first reading of the 2025-2026 employee handbook. Ms. Walker is working on a scavenger hunt to engage staff. The handbook is with employers council for review.
- 2.3 The calendar will have a few adjustments for next school year. School will start five days earlier to accommodate inclement weather days.

#### 3.0 Financials

- **3.1** Theresa Shoda shared the first reading of the FY 2025-2026 budget. Our current student projection is 775 students. There looks to be an increase in funding for the next fiscal year. ESSER funding is now wrapped up. JoAnne Ballard shared that there have been long conversations about enrollment and the projection of 775 students is a healthy number at this current time.
- **3.2** Theresa Shoda gave a financial update on the March 2025 budgets. Ms. Shoda shared that we are currently at 75% of the budget which is right where we should be. Revenues will continue to roll in for April, May and June.
